4. Specific factors affecting the risk:


Dancing near the shisha pipe

5. Control measures in place at the time of assessment:

Site supervision, Personal Protective Equipment including gloves.

Burns – Zero
General Client Hazards – Tolerable
Smoke inhalation - Zero
OVERALL RISK EVALUATION: Low



**7. Further action necessary to control the risks identified :** Use carpet or Grass floor – Special Shisha Pipe smoking area.

**8. Persons responsible for implementing control measures :** The venue owner and the shisha pipe representative.

9. Schedule for improvement: Every Month
